Executive Summary

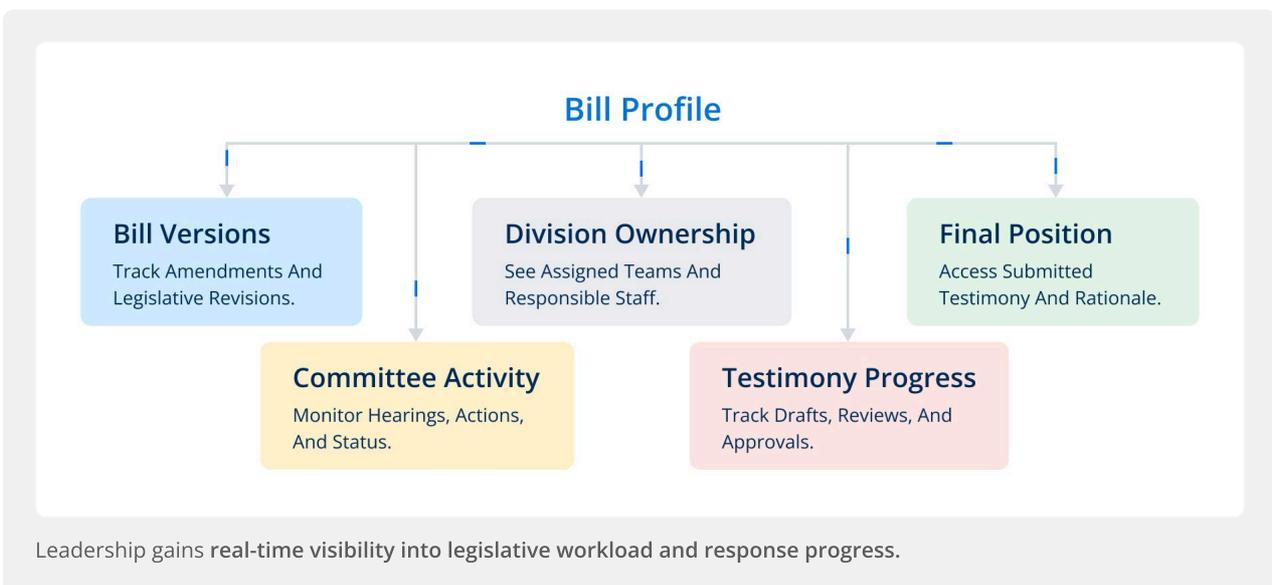

Testimony Text

The Department of Transportation submits comments in support with amendments for Senate Bill 4271, SD2, which proposes the modernization of statewide transportation asset monitoring through the adoption of integrated digital infrastructure reporting systems.

The bill aims to establish a coordinated framework for collecting, sharing, and analyzing infrastructure performance data across multiple state agencies responsible for transportation planning, roadway maintenance, and capital improvement projects. By enabling consistent reporting standards and shared analytics capabilities, the legislation has the potential to improve long-term asset management and support more informed budgetary decisions.

The Department recognizes the importance of modernizing infrastructure oversight and acknowledges the benefits of centralized data visibility for planning, safety monitoring, and performance evaluation. Enhanced reporting capabilities would allow state agencies to identify maintenance needs earlier, prioritize critical repairs, and align investment decisions with statewide transportation goals.

However, the Department recommends several technical amendments to ensure successful implementation. Specifically, additional clarity may be required regarding system integration standards, data governance responsibilities, and funding mechanisms for agencies responsible for maintaining infrastructure reporting systems. Establishing clear operational guidelines will help ensure that the proposed framework can be implemented consistently across departments while minimizing administrative burden.

The Department also recommends language that encourages coordination between state and county transportation agencies to ensure compatibility of infrastructure data and reporting systems. Collaboration across jurisdictions will strengthen the overall effectiveness of the program and support more comprehensive transportation planning across the state....

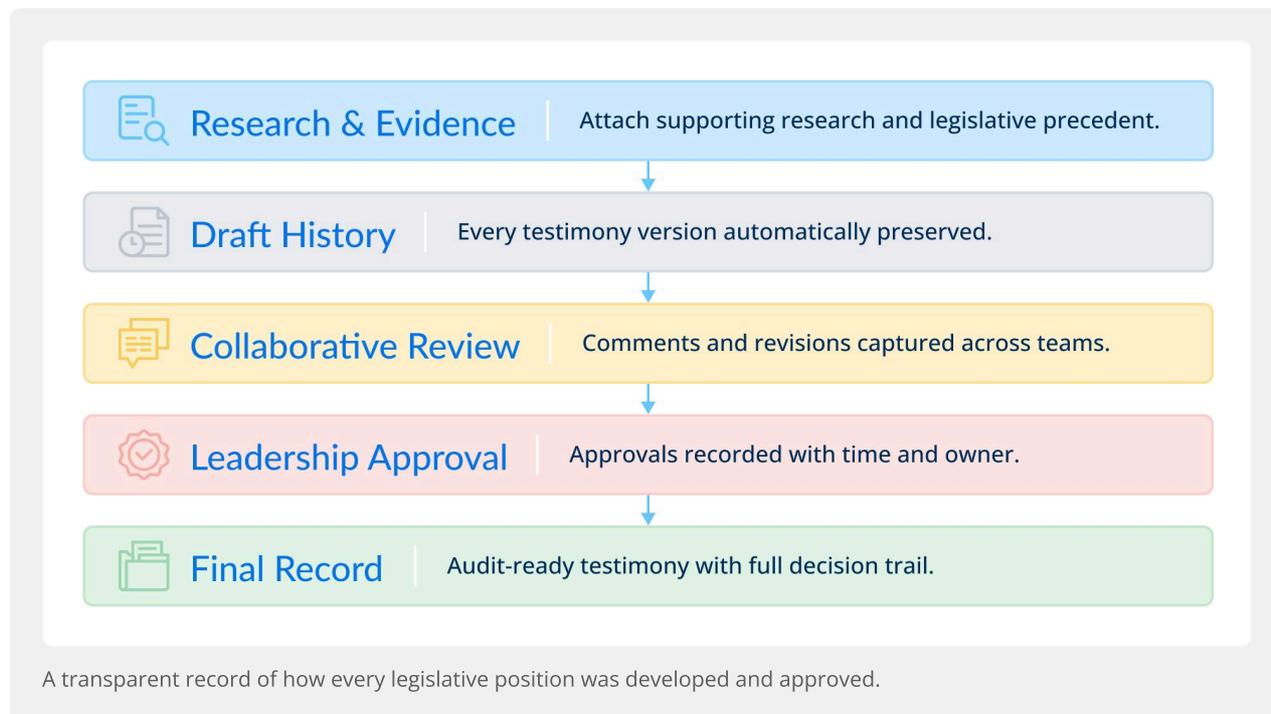
